

## **Assisted Living Visit Checklist**

Assisted living promises to help maintain independence by offering support with the activities of daily living. So what do you need to look for to choose the right community? Start with this checklist when you visit and tour.

Location:	Financial Affairs:
Community is conveniently located for family and friends to visit	You have a list of services included in the monthly resident fee - and a list
Surrounding neighborhood is safe and free of crime	of additional possible monthly fees  You have a list of care charges
Entertainment venues, shopping centers and restaurants are close by	Housekeeping and laundry services are included in the monthly fee
Medical facilities – and personal physician – are near	Transportation is included or assessed an additional fee
Personal Care & Support Services:	Monthly fees change annually, with advance notice of the change given to residents
What is the staff-to-resident ratio?	<b>Caregiver Experience</b>
A nurse is on-site or on-call 24/7	& Training:
The community is well staffed during the overnight hours	Background checks are completed prior to hire
A 24-hour emergency response system is in place	Staff is screened and evaluated for their ability to work with older adults
A plan is in place for the resident who needs additional care and support, including moving to a different care community	in the assisted living setting
	The community has its most recent survey results posted or displayed for families to review
During visit, residents appear look tidy and well cared for	Staff are trained and retrained and regular intervals
Caregivers interact with residents in positive, calm and respectful ways	
Visitors are greeted promptly and warmly	



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<b>Life Enrichment Programs:</b>	Residents may invite guests for meals
Activities are scheduled throughout the day and evening	The community accommodates special diets
Programs are offered that engage mind, body and spirit	Dietician or nutritionist is involved in meal planning
Senior-friendly fitness classes are included	Physical Plant:
Craft groups, card clubs and informal resident gatherings have well-lighted, convenient, dedicated spaces	Resident apartments have safety features including an emergency alert system and a fire suppression system
Regular outings to movie theater, local restaurants, museums and other destinations of interest to	Safety features are in place such as handrails and grab bars
residents – transportation included – are scheduled	Residents are free to decorate their apartments according to their personal taste
Outdoor spaces are available for walking, gardening and recreation	Additional storage is available for residents
<b>Dining Services:</b>	Community is clean and well maintained
Dining room looks and smells inviting, and the setting allows easy access for wheelchairs and assisted walking	Parking area is convenient and well lighted
Dining room table, chairs and linens are clean and in good condition	And finally, note how you feel.  Does the community look and
Residents can choose their own meal times	feel like a place you would be comfortable calling home?
Residents dine during designated meal times only	If you have the chance to interact with other residents
Three daily meals, snacks and beverages are included in the monthly rate	and their families, what can they tell you about the community?
